## Monday, March 28 - Depart USA to Tel Aviv

Your journey begins as you depart the United States on your international flight to Israel.

## Tuesday, March 29 - Arrive in Tel Aviv, Transfer to Tiberius for Dinner and Overnight

Arrive into Tel Aviv. You will be met by a representative and transferred to your hotel in Tiberius for dinner and overnight.

## Wednesday, March 30 - Caesarea, Mt. Carmel, Megiddo, Nazareth, Cana, Tiberius

Begin your journey of a lifetime today as you visit Caesarea on the Mediterranean Sea, where Paul made his defense before Festus and King Agrippa prior to his final journey to Rome (Acts 25-26). Look out over the Valley of Jezreel from the heights of Mount Carmel. On this mount, Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Visit Megiddo and the Valley of Armageddon (Revelation 16). Visit Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus (Matthew 2:23). Recall Jesus' first miracle as you pass through Cana (John 2). Return to Tiberius for dinner and overnight.

## Thursday, March 31 - Sea of Galilee, Capernaum, Mt. of Beatitudes, Tabgha, Boat Ride, Jordan River

Drive along the shores of the Sea of Galilee, passing the area of Magdala, home of Mary Magdalene. Next travel to Capernaum, and stand in the ruins of the synagogue built atop the remains of the one in which Jesus taught. See the excavations that include where Peter's house is thought to have been located. Visit the peaceful Mount of Beatitudes that overlooks the Sea of Galilee. On this hill, Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7). Stop at Tabgha, where the feeding of the 5,000 is remembered at the Church of the Fish and Loaves (Luke 9). Enjoy a St. Peter's Fish Dinner at the Ein Gev kibbutz. With your Bible in hand, cross the waters of the Sea of Galilee aboard a Kinnereth Sailing Company boat. Remember your baptism at the Yardenit Baptismal site, where the Jordan River exits the Sea of Galilee on its journey southward (Matthew 3). Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

## Friday, April 1 - Caesarea Philippi, Dan, Golan Heights, Chorazim

Visit Caesarea Philippi, where Jesus traveled with His disciples and where nearby Peter proclaimed to Jesus, "You are the Christ!" (Matthew 16:16). Visit Tel Dan, one of ancient Israel's boundary markers - "From Dan to Beersheba." Travel through the Golan Heights and better understand their strategic importance to the security of Israel. Walk the streets of Chorazim, listed as a "city of woe" by Jesus (Matthew 11). Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

## Saturday, April 2 - Gideon's Spring (Harod), Beth Shean, Jordan Valley, Qumran, Masada, Dead Sea

Visit Gideon's Spring (Ein Harod) where Gideon chose his army of 300 by observing how they drank from the springs (Judges 7). Next it's on to the magnificent ruins of Beth Shean where you will tour the impressive excavations of Scythopolis, one of the ten cities of the Decapolis. Travel through the Jordan Valley. Visit Qumran, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery, to discuss the mysterious community of Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. Enjoy a visit to Masada, the spectacular mountaintop



fortress built by Herod and famous as the last stronghold of the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore the fortress. Peer down upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. Time permitting, you'll stop briefly at the Shores of the Dead Sea for a quick dip in the salt and mineral laden waters. Arrive at your Jerusalem hotel for dinner and overnight.

### **Sunday, April 3 - Bethlehem, Shepherd's Field, Mt. Zion, Upper Room, Caiaphas' House, Yad Vashem**

Cross the border into Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus (Luke 2). Look out on the Shepherd's Fields, where angels spread the Good News. Journey to Mt. Zion and stand in the Upper Room, revered as the place of the Last Supper (Mark 14:12-26). View the site of King David's Tomb. Walk through some of the ancient rooms of Caiaphas the High Priest's house. Here it is believed that Jesus was held overnight before His crucifixion (Luke 22). Walk through the Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial and be touched by its poignant images. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

### **Monday, April 4 - Mt. of Olives, Site of the Ascension, Garden of Gethsemane, Emmaus, Valley of Elah, Samuel's Tomb**

Stand atop the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem. Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1:9-12). The Chapel of the Ascension marks the traditional site. Pray in the Garden of Gethsemane among Olive Trees in the Kidron Valley across from the walls of Jerusalem. Walk the Emmaus Road where Jesus appeared to two travelers on the evening of the resurrection (Luke 24:13-35). Journey through the Valley of Elah where David defeated Goliath (1 Samuel 17). Visit Nebi Samuel, thought to be the burial place of the prophet Samuel. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

### **Tuesday, April 5 - Temple Mount, Old City, Sister's of Zion Church, Pool of Bethesda, Church of the Holy Sepulcher, Late Night Transfer to Airport**

Today see the Temple Mount, once the site of the Temple of Solomon. Visit the Old City of Jerusalem and discover the sights and sounds from the modern shops among the remains of the ancient city. Visit the Lithostrotos at the Convent of the Sisters of Zion. This area of pavement constructed with large slabs is associated with the condemnation of Jesus by Pilate. (John 19) The pavement also has a Roman "King's Game" board carved to be used as a dice game. It recalls the casting of lots for Jesus' clothing after his crucifixion (John 19). View the Pool of Bethesda (John 5:1-31) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle. Stand in reverence at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. This evening you will be transferred to the airport for your late night flight back to the USA.

### **Wednesday, April 6 - Arrive USA**

Arrive home with memories that will last a lifetime!
